2 Timothy 4:1-8

Gospel Lesson

John 4:1-10

Jesus Talks With a Samaritan Woman

- 4 Now Jesus learned that the Pharisees had heard that he was gaining and baptizing more disciples than John—² although in fact it was not Jesus who baptized, but his disciples. ³ So he left Judea and went back once more to Galilee.
- ⁴ Now he had to go through Samaria. ⁵ So he came to a town in Samaria called Sychar, near the plot of ground Jacob had given to his son Joseph. ⁶ Jacob's well was there, and Jesus, tired as he was from the journey, sat down by the well. It was about noon.
- ⁷When a Samaritan woman came to draw water, Jesus said to her, "Will you give me a drink?" ⁸(His disciples had gone into the town to buy food.)
- ⁹The Samaritan woman said to him, "You are a Jew and I am a Samaritan woman. How can you ask me for a drink?" (For Jews do not associate with Samaritans.)
- 10 Jesus answered her, "If you knew the gift of God and who it is that asks you for a drink, you would have asked him and he would have given you living water."

This is the word of God for the people of God.

Message

Church - How

Good morning, Church Family! I hope you had a blessed week in Christ and experienced God's love and grace in your lives.

I have preached about the church to find the directions and ways of the church. I hope we get insights from the message while we are considering the messages. Also, I have asked you to think of the church and pray for the church for three minutes every day. Please think of the church and pray for the church for three minutes every day. Your prayers and meditations are precious and powerful. Your prayers and meditations will help the church a lot.

Last Sunday, we considered the mission and goal of the church based on the book, *Developing an Intentional Discipleship System*. What do we do as a church family? We do make disciples. We do our ministry to make disciples of Jesus Christ for the transformation of the world. This is what we do and why we do the church ministry. This is the mission and goal of the church. Please remember that your service to the church and God is precious and important for God's ministry, making disciples. Nothing is minor or small whatever you do or participate in. You are making disciples through your gifts, talents, strength, prayer, presence, witness, giving, and service.

Today I want us to consider the 'How' of the church based on the same book while we consider the 'What' and the 'Why' of the church last Sunday. We remind ourselves of what we do and why we do the ministry as a church community. It is 'Making Disciples.' Then, how can we make disciples? Yes, we make disciples through our ministry. We do our church ministries, such as worship, small group, mission, giving, and witness to make disciples. Then what else can we do?

The author of the book, Junius Dotson, encourages the church to have an Intentional Discipleship System. An Intentional Discipleship System is the pathway that we can help others to be disciples of Jesus.

Before we consider the disciple system more, let us define the word, disciple, first. Who is a disciple? Dotson refers to the understanding of a disciple from the Book of Discipline, UMC's rule book so-called. The definition is this: "A disciple is a witness to Jesus Christ in the world who follows His teachings through acts of compassion, justice, worship, and devotion under the guidance of the Holy Spirit." And he also gives us his understanding of a disciple based on the definition with easy words: "A disciple is one who knows Christ, is growing in Christ, Serving Christ, and sharing Christ.

A Discipleship system means all kinds of the ministry of the church that serves people to get to know Jesus and grow in Christ, serve Christ, and share Christ. Knowing Jesus, growing in Jesus, serving Jesus, and sharing Jesus are the pathway to discipleship and Worship, small group, mission, giving, and evangelism are the ministries for each path as part of the system. There are churches that have their own system. For example, Peace UMC in Ohio called the system *Discipleship Pathway*. As you see in the picture, their system consists of these categories: Unaware of Christ, Exploring Christ, Committed to Christ, Following Christ, and Fully Submitted to Christ. And each ministry, such as Small groups or Classes, supports people to take the path. Western Pennsylvania Annual Conference created a system called, The Road to Discipleship. As you see in the picture, their categories are Exploring Christ, Transforming in Christ, Maturing in Christ, and centered in Christ. And each ministry includes classes, small groups, and service opportunities that support people going on the road to discipleship.

What do you think? Why do they have a system for discipleship? Yes, to make disciples, they built a system because a system has the power to lead people to go on the path. Most organizations have a system based on their goal and the system is designed to fulfill the goal and support the organization to fulfill the goal. A system can give the organization efficiency in their work. I believe that the churches built or want to build a discipleship system to achieve the mission of the church. What do you think? Do we need a discipleship system? What pathway and categories would be good for us? What current ministries can we place in each category? What ministry do we need more for each category to enforce the stage of the pathway?

Please focus on the word, 'Intentional,' in the title of the book, Developing an Intentional Discipleship System. The author uses the words, 'an intentional discipleship system' rather than 'a discipleship system.' The word, 'intentional,' means doing something on purpose. When the church has an intentional discipleship system, the church does the ministry on the purpose of making disciples and their will and desire. In easy words, they do the ministry and run the system with the heart of the mission of the church, the 'what' and the 'why' as we talked about last Sunday.

Church family, our mission is making disciples and we are called for the great commission. In today's scripture, Paul urges Timothy, "proclaim the message; be persistent whether the time is favorable or unfavorable; convince, rebuke, and encourage with the utmost patience in teaching." (1 Timothy 4:2) Timothy was a missionary and a pastor. Paul chose Timothy as his companion when he went on the second mission trip. During their mission trip and Paul's first mission trip, many new churches were established. Paul sent Timothy to the churches to care for them. They were like a mentor and a mentee. Paul taught him and gave him his advice. Now

Paul says to him "Always proclaim the gospel, the Good news, to the people whether it is a good time or a bad time." Paul wanted to remind him of the mission and God's calling for them, spreading out the gospel, making disciples of Jesus Christ sharing God's love and grace, the purpose of their ministry, and their lives. Whether the time is favorable or unfavorable, we should proclaim the Gospel. Whether the time is favorable or unfavorable, we should make disciples of Jesus Christ.

In today's Gospel lesson, Jesus met a Samaritan woman while his disciples went to get food. It could be a short time for him to rest in his busy schedule. However, when he saw her, he used the time to share God's love and grace and teach her the truth of the kingdom of God through the conversation with her. Jesus led the woman to accept God's love and grace and follow God's will and desire.

Little Falls Church family,

I pray that we together intentionally make disciples through our church ministry and personal ministry following Jesus' calling, God's will, and desire. We are the fruits of the ministry of our saints who helped us to be Christians, the followers of Jesus, and the disciples of Jesus. We became Christians through our family mostly, friends, and neighbors' efforts and service. I think these days are different from the old days. The time would not be favorable for us to help new people to be disciples of Jesus compared to the old times. However, we still have the same mission and goal, the same calling and purpose in our lives. Let us cheer ourselves up to fulfill our mission and goal in Christ, asking for God's strength, courage, and wisdom. John Wesley, the founder of the UMC said, "I am not afraid that the people called Methodists should ever cease to exist either in Europe or America. But I am afraid, lest they should only exist as a dead sect, having the form of religion without the power." We don't want to become a dead sect but faithful and powerful Christians, as the church family. Let us do our ministry with the heart of Jesus. Let us have the missional mindset to make disciples. Let us make a system or systems together if we need. We are the church, the people having faith in God, growing in Christ, serving Christ, and sharing Christ. We are here to make disciples of Jesus Christ. God will help us with each process. God will show the way. God will give us God's wisdom, insights, strength, resources, and power when we seek God's desire and will. Let us make disciples. Amen!
